Class Definitions:

Note: If there is ambiguity about a car's eligibility, the judge's decision will be final.

Hot Rods: all years, The National Street Rod Association defines a hot rod as an "automobile of 1948 or earlier that has undergone some modernization to the engine, transmission, interior, or anything else. A hot rod is designed for racing." They are usually old or classic American cars with modified engines.

Rat Rods: all years, custom car with a deliberately worn-down, unfinished appearance, typically lacking paint, showing rust, and made from cheap or cast-off components.

Vintage: Stock cars up to 1949, very limited modifications allowed, period accessories.

Classic: Stock cars up to 1983, very limited modifications allowed, period accessories.

Muscle Cars – pre-1980: Large, two-door, boxy cars with large capacity engines, typically Dodge, Chevrolet, or Ford.

Muscle Cars – post-1980: Large, two-door, boxy cars with large capacity engines, typically Dodge, Chevrolet, or Ford.

Trucks: All years, anything goes!

Student: Any vehicle, including motorcycles, any condition as long as it's currently roadworthy, any year, entrant age limit is 25 and must be enrolled in school, college, or university. Entry fee for this class only is \$15.

Trophies:

- 1. There must be a minimum of 2 entries in the class for a first place trophy to be awarded.
- 2. There must be a minimum of 5 entries in the class for a second place trophy to be awarded.
- 3. There will be a discretionary trophy awarded by the Grand Marshal.
